

The Community of Springdale in Brampton



- Springdale is one of the five Peel communities where Peel Newcomer Strategy Group is working with the local institutions and organization to develop a coordinated **Service Delivery Network (SDN)** that meets the needs of this particular community.

- **Punjabi Community Health Services** is playing a facilitating role to bring together all the stakeholders in this community together.

The population of Springdale was 83,025 in 2011 with **42.6%** of its residents moving in the last 5 years (either moving into Springdale or out of it). Overall half of the population in this neighbourhood identified as South Asian. In Springdale, 7.4% (6,120) of residents do not speak an official language. The top 3 languages spoken across this neighbourhood are: Punjabi (26.0%), Gujarati (1.4%) and Urdu (0.8%). The **top 5 visible minorities** are: South Asian (59.0%), Black (13.0%), Filipino (2.4%), Southeast Asian (2.1%) and Latin American (1.7%).

The income groups are as follows:

Under \$5,000 – 21.8% (13,575)
 \$5,000-\$39,999 – 54.1% (33,610)
 \$40,000 - \$79,999 – 21.7% (13,480)
 \$80,000 and over – 2.3% (1,460)

Additionally, **31.3%** (19,460) of residents spend 30% or more of their household total income on shelter costs.
